- A recent independent study, using mixed-method, quasi-experimental designs, found that Istation had a statistically significant effect on the literacy learning of students in the study. - Results indicated that Istation had a statistically significant effect on the early literacy skills of the kindergarten students studied and could explain 17.7% of the variance in group differences.
- Students in grades 1-5 who moderately used the curriculum grew an average of 61.6% beyond students who did not use it. That growth increased to 84.4% for students who used the Istation programs for 400 minutes or more per academic year.
- Students in grades 6-8 grew an average of 15.6% beyond students not using the program; with a growth increase of 67.2% for students who used the program for 400 minutes or more per academic year.
- Students, who use the Istation program at a minimum usage of 400 minutes per academic year, grow at a faster rate than those who have not used the program. And, those who are struggling grow at a faster rate when using Istation's educational technology.
